- Thesis Supervision:

 - The thesis is typically 150 to 300 pages long and follows a traditional structure, including sections like literature review, methodology, results, and conclusions.
- Certificate of Research in Business Administration: At the end of the first year of training and after completing the first five seminars, students will receive a *Certificate of Research in Business Administration* from MESOS Business School. This certificate recognizes the student's foundational research skills and progress in the program.
